

Directorate of Government Schools Reviews Short Monitoring Visit Report

Jidhafs Intermediate Boys School Jiblat Hebshi - Northern Governorate Kingdom of Bahrain

Introduction

The monitoring visit of the school took place over one day, by a monitoring team from the Directorate of Government Schools Reviews (DGS) of the Education & Training Quality Authority (BQA) to verify the improvements that it enacted according to the recommendations of the last review visit. During the monitoring visit, improvement in students' performance is evaluated during the class observation, the learning walk, scrutiny of their written works and monitoring of general progress.

Summary of the first monitoring results

• The school needs a second monitoring visit after one year.

The overall outcomes of the visit

In order to have sufficient measures and improvements, the school is required to:

- Seek immediate intervention by the relevant parties at Ministry of Education to bring about the desired improvement in the overall performance with focus on:
 - raising students' academic achievement and enabling them to acquire the basic skills
 - ensuring students' safety and security through maintaining the school building and monitoring student dismissal.
- Carry out a more rigorous and comprehensive self-evaluation and benefit from its results in developing the strategic, action and departmental plans according to accurate performance indicators and clear monitoring mechanisms.
- Monitor the impact of teachers' professional competency raising programmes on the development of teaching and learning to focus on:
 - using effective teaching strategies
 - motivating and encouraging students to ensure their motivation to learn
 - employing effective assessment methods and benefiting from their results in meeting all students' needs
 - managing lessons in an organised and productive manner.
- Improve the efficiency of personal and academic support programmes provided to students in lessons and school programmes.
- Address the shortfall in human resources represented by the social guidance department.

Additional remarks

• The school needs to address the shortfall in human resources represented by teachers for the following departments: 2 for Islamic education, 2 for family education, 1 for art and 1 for agriculture, in addition to its need to complete the social guidance team.
