

Directorate of Government Schools Reviews Short Monitoring Visit Report

East Rifaa Primary Boys School East Riffa – Southern Governorate Kingdom of Bahrain

Introduction

The monitoring visit of the school took place over one day, by a monitoring team from the Directorate of Government Schools Reviews (DGS) of the Education & Training Quality Authority (BQA) to verify the improvements that it enacted according to the recommendations of the last review visit. During the monitoring visit, improvement in students' performance is evaluated during the class observation, the learning walk, scrutiny of their written works and monitoring of general progress.

Summary of the first monitoring results

The overall outcomes of the visit

In order to have sufficient measures and improvements, the school is required to:

- Seek prompt intervention by the relevant parties at the Ministry of Education (MoE); to evaluate the faultlessness of the school's building and environment, and support the school's overall efforts.
- Apply accurate comprehensive self-evaluation mechanisms of all schoolwork aspects, and benefit from their results in setting a strategic plan that covers the school's development priorities.
- Continue enhancing the applied procedures; to solve students' problems; to ensure their security and psychological safety, and to promote their motivation towards learning, in addition to conducting projects and programmes that aim at raising their awareness and improve their conduct.
- Raise students' academic achievement level; to develop their basic skills in all subjects, while focusing on:
 - applying various effective teaching and learning strategies.
 - varying assessment techniques, and benefiting from their results in planning for lessons and written work.
 - managing classroom; to ensure students' participation in the educational activities and utilization of learning time to achieve lessons' objectives.
- Support and assist all students to meeting their academic, personal and health needs in and outside lessons.
- Continue addressing the shortage in human resources; represented by:
 - Senior teachers for the class teaching system and the core subjects.
 - speech and communication specialist, social worker.
 - a nurse.

Additional remarks

• The school should, in addition to the above mentioned, ensure students' safety and security at times of attendance and departure.
