Guidelines for Parents





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Dear Parent,

The National Examinations are conducted annually for Grade 9 and Grade 12 students. The purpose of Grade 9 National Examinations is to assess students' abilities and skills within the competencies of the national curriculum at the end of basic education.

The purpose of Grade 12 National Examinations is to measure students' achievement of educational objectives in the Kingdom of Bahrain after completing 12 years of study. Therefore, we would like to summarise the key points to be considered and ensured before your child takes the National Examinations:



Ensure to review the schedule of National Examinations and inform your child about it in advance.



Encourage your child to practise on previous National Examinations samples available on the official website of the Education and Training Quality Authority (BQA).



Create a suitable home environment to facilitate studying and preparing for the National Examinations.



Ensure that your child arrives at school early and provide them with the necessary stationery tools.
